Enhancing Primary Education in the Philippines

ABM invites us to support the growth of St Mark's Learning Centre in the Episcopal Church's diocese of Santiago in the Philippines, as it provides an educational future for hundreds of local children.

The Centre will offer classes from Nursery to Grade 7 (currently offering Nursey to Grade 2), increasing by one grade per year.

ABM AID has been asked for help to build a 2 storey building housing 8 classrooms on the site of the existing Children's learning Cantre. The plan is by the end of 2028 to have all the elementary school grades, up to and including Grade7. Each year the plan is to add an additional classroom.

As well as classrooms, the building will include toilets, a laboratory and library, all being accessible to children and adults with disabilities.
